The City of Greater Sudbury Community Development Corporation is a non-share, not-for-profit corporation, incorporated under the Business Corporations Act and Municipal Act.

Responsible to the Manager of Economic Development, the role of the Board of Directors will be to strengthen and enhance economic development within the City of Greater Sudbury. The Board will actively promote the economic health and prosperity of the City of Greater Sudbury by advancing the City as a world centre for excellence in information technology/telecommunications, mining technology, environmental technology, education and training, business services, tourism and retail, health, government, transportation and distribution services.

Time Commitment: The Board of Directors meets once a month; ten times a year.

It is expected that meetings will be held on a regular day each month, commencing at 11:30 a.m. Board meetings typically last 2.5 hours. Occasionally, Members of the Board may be required to hold their meeting in various locations throughout the City of Greater Sudbury. Applicants should either have their own vehicle or access to one.

Agendas are circulated prior to each meeting and provide the necessary background for discussions and decisions.

Remuneration: This is an unpaid volunteer position.

Term of Appointment: Appointments to the Board of Directors will be 2 or 3 year terms.
