FULL-TIME CONSTRUCTION ON KINGSWAY ‘S’ CURVE STARTS THURSDAY

Motorists are advised of traffic delays on the Kingsway, starting at 7 a.m. on Thursday, May 7.

The Kingsway ‘S’ curve, between the Lloyd Street hill and Kitchener Avenue, is under construction to complete a major water and sewer main replacement project which began last fall.

Preparatory work for construction has ended. Starting tomorrow, a full-time construction schedule will reduce this section of the Kingsway to one lane in each direction between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. each day. Motorists are advised to consider alternate routes during peak traffic periods.

Curbs, sidewalks and final paving on the Kingsway ‘S’ curve are scheduled to be complete by June 15.

Elsewhere in the city, the southbound curb lane on Regent Street, between Remington Road and Mallard’s Landing, is closed until 3 p.m. today, May 6, to provide access for a private contractor.

Overnight work on Regent Street will close the northbound curb lane between York and McLeod Streets between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. starting tonight, May 6 through Saturday, May 9, to provide access for a Bell Canada contractor.
